Women's Liberation Front is committed to nonviolence. We work within our country's legal and political system to enact change. Nonviolence does not mean avoiding conflict. Quite the contrary: it is action — direct confrontation with power — that is nonviolent. At WoLF, we take issues head-on, but act professionally and diplomatically. The truth of our feminist work speaks louder and more persuasively than any threat.
