The WoLF New York Public Opinion Survey was conducted by IVR and Online Mobile Interviews from March 12 - March 15 among a random sample of 1000 likely voters. The survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.1 percentage points. Results are weighted. Some percentages in crosstab reports for this poll may not add to 100% due to rounding.
