The surveys presented in this report were performed by Ryan Burrell, President of Spry Strategies, using multi-mode interviews combining traditional live callers, online panels and online mobile applications. The scientific random sampling double screened likely voters who voted in at least two of 2012, 2014, 2016 \& 2018 primary or general elections, as well as newly registered voters from May 1, 2018 - May 20, 2020.

The range of error of margin for the surveys reported are between 3-5 percent. The survey turnout models are based on the 2020 presidential election for age, race, gender and party affiliation.
